

Appendix A: The Committee on Competitive Interests

Section 1: Scope

- A) The Committee on Competitive Interests (CCI) shall only exist during times in which UIMT has no Head Coach.
- B) The CCI shall be chaired by the President.
- C) The CCI shall be responsible for creating an educational and highly competitive environment within UIMT that embodies excellence, integrity, and civility.
 - 1. If a member of the CCI believes they cannot be objective in their decisions, they shall resign immediately.
 - 2. Any acts of impropriety by a member of the CCI shall be considered to be a felony under Article IV §4.
- D) The CCI shall be responsible for the selection of the first team(s) of the season
 - 1. This selection shall be based on tryouts viewed by the CCI.
 - a. Any member of UIMT who wishes to be considered for a position on the first team(s) must tryout unless he or she is on the CCI.
 - 2. The CCI shall create as many teams as it deems desirable based on the number of members who tryout and the available talent pool.
 - a. A roster of each proposed team must be submitted to the Executive Council for affirmation.
 - 3. The CCI shall appoint a captain or co-captains to each team, which must be affirmed by the Executive Council.
 - a. A person may decline to accept an appointment as a captain
- E) The CCI shall be responsible for responsible for scheduling tournaments for UIMT
 - 1. All tournaments chosen by the CCI shall be submitted to the Finance Committee for approval.
- F) The CCI shall function as the liaison between UIMT and AMTA and/or other schools' coaching staffs.
- G) The CCI shall be responsible for appointing new coaches
 - 1. Such appointments must be affirmed by the Executive Council.
 - 2. It shall be the responsibility of the chair of the CCI to handle all communications with persons being considered for a coaching position.
